The Africa Group acknowledges that the death of Professor John Hearn is a big loss to the family, relatives, and friends of the late Professor John Hearn. Equally, that it is a very big loss to both Australia and Africa, firstly in the academic worlds, and secondly, in the broader context of Australia-Africa cooperation.

In the late Professor John Hearn, both Australia and Africa have lost a visionary and proponent of strong Australia-Africa relations.

The African diplomatic community and scholars from Africa are poorer with the passing on of Professor John Hearn, the co-founder of the Australia-Africa University Network (AAUN) who was a pillar of support and strength of the AAUN which until his death he served as the co-chair on the Australian side of the AAUN.

The late Professor John Hearn was convinced that the AAUN holds the potential of strengthening Australia-Africa relations firstly, through fostering people to people contacts and also by developing a shared human resource base that serves as a catalyst for forging mutually beneficial academic research and development, cultivating technological relations and advancing sustainable socio-economic relations.

The late Professor John Hearn leaves behind to each one of us who occupy both the academic and cross-sectoral policy space the huge challenge of building strong Australia-Africa academic and overall relations.

We are all further challenged to embrace with humility and wisdom all that the late Professor John Hearn stood for. It is aptly said that a great man does not die because his great works continue to live long after he has left the planet Earth.
